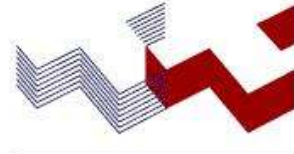

TST EXPANDS OPERATIONS INTO EUROPE VIA LONDON, ENGLAND

VANCOUVER – With the United Kingdom’s new gambling regulatory regime well on its way executives of Technical Systems Testing (TST) have announced the opening of its newest Test House in London as of 1 March 2008.

As one of the world’s most experienced test houses for both land-based and remote (interactive) gaming, TST sees a continuing demand for high quality testing and client support balanced with business efficacy. “Satisfying this demand has proven to be a key factor for our success, and in turn allowed us to undertake this expansion, which I believe will ultimately benefit both the local gaming market and our clients internationally” according to TST’s Chief Operating Officer, Mr. Salim Adatia.

The expansion decision further proves TST’s commitment to playing an active role in the European gaming market. Although it has been active in the UK since 2003 from its laboratories remotely in North America and Australia, by positioning the testing house in London’s borough of Hammersmith, TST will be able to enhance the speed and responsiveness of the service that we continually seek to provide to our valued clients.

On 1 June 2007 TST was approved as a Test House by the UK’s Gambling Commission. Originally set up under the Gambling Act 2005 the Gambling Commission has taken over the role previously played by the Gaming Board for Great Britain in regulating casinos, bingo, gaming machines and lotteries. The Gambling Commission is also responsible for the regulation of betting and remote gambling, as well as helping to protect children and other vulnerable citizens.

TST believes that the UK gaming market will be closely observed by emerging-market economies that are working towards developing or reshaping their gaming technical standards to more accurately address technological advancements. TST’s Chief Executive Officer, Mr. John Cargnello stated “We believe that the resultant geographic distribution of our Test Houses reflects market demand and better meets the needs and wants of our customers internationally.”

“We are please to have the opportunity to ensure fairness, security and technical integrity of land-based and remote gaming systems in the UK,” stated Noah Turner, TST’s Chief Technical Officer.
